Opening Thought

Reading 1: Isaiah 35: 1-10

Take some time, as a group, to pray for one another.

Welcome:

Elijah the Tishbite from Tishbe. We know already that Elijah is one of the great Old Testament prophets. Elijah is a man of God. Elijah will worship and serve the one, true, living God.

King Ahab has led Israel away from their God.

False gods have replaced worship of the one, true God. God has pronounced judgement on the land and a severe drought has afflicted people for 3 years. Think how badly a nation would be impacted by a long, severe drought.

King Ahab wants to find Elijah.

Read: 1 Kings 18: 1-15

- What do we know about Obadiah?
- What do we know about King Ahab?

- Describe the meeting between Obadiah and Elijah.
- Is it right for Christians to serve in government? Even when that government makes policies and decisions that threaten God's people?

Read: 1 Kings 18: 16-46

- Describe the meeting between Elijah and Ahab.
- What does Elijah set up the contest on Mount Carmel? What are the risks?
- How do the prophets of Baal and Asherah react to the situation?
- Why does Elijah make the context even harder than it needs to be?
- Look at verses 41-46. What does this mean for Elijah and Ahab?
